

Climb aboard our custom dory boat, complete with a built-in cooler, and experience a float trip down special sections of the Roaring Fork River that most never get to see.




Practice makes perfect - before heading out on the river our guides will teach you how to properly cast.

Let our adventure concierge show you the rugged beauty of Aspen with an off-road trip. Offered as two- or four-hour outings with snack or lunch selections from Element 47.








Biking

Stargazing Tours




ASPEN MOUNTAIN STARGAZING TOUR

Ascend the backside of Aspen Mountain as the sun sets, and arrive to the top of the mountain just as the night sky appears. Your astronomy expert will provide binoculars and identify stars, constellations, planets and much more, and will answer any questions you have. Blankets will be provided, but extra layers are recommended such as a fleece jacket and jeans. These outings are approximately two and a half hours round trip. Departure time varies slightly throughout the summer, depending on sunset.

T-LAZY-7 TELESCOPE TOUR

Venture to T-Lazy-7 Ranch in the Maroon Creek Valley with your adventure guide and an astronomer. Using a high-powered telescope, you'll observe stars, planets, nebulae and galaxies that cannot be seen with the naked eye. This trip is approximately two hours.
