Led by Executive Chef Matt Zubrod, Chef de Cuisine Patrick Dunn, Pastry Chef Curtis Cameron and Wine Director and Master Sommelier Carlton McCoy, Aspen's only Five-Star restaurant (also a Wine Enthusiast Top 100 restaurant and Wine Spectator Grand Award winner) is part contemporary art gallery with its indoor and patio dining, a New American-style menu, 20,000-bottle cellar and 43 sommeliers on staff (throughout the hotel).





#### In the Garden

Explore the floral courtyard at The Nell, which includes the first living wall in Aspen that's designed in the Power of Four motif of our parent company, Aspen Snowmass – mimicking the four ski areas. Complimentary Garden Tours are offered on Fridays at 4 p.m. with our British-born, Chelsea Flower Show-going resident gardener. This summer, we also established a garden at nearby Emma Farms with 30 beds of produce, herbs and vegetables for our restaurants.

### Best Seat in Aspen - Ajax Tavern

When you say "apres-ski," most people picture something strikingly similar to Ajax Tavern – a sun-drenched, mountainside patio with prime people-watching. Chef J.D. Baldridge's menu focuses on French classics (never miss the truffle fries or Rosé for days). This summer's three-part BBQ Series features a Clam Bake, Colorado BBQ and our 5th Annual Rocky Mountain Oyster Festival and the the Ajax Music Series features entertainment Fridays-Sundays from 3-6 p.m. along with food & drink specials.





#### Renovations

The Residences at The Little Nell's renovations of its 26 luxurious residences and 8 hotel rooms with Caroline-Edwards of Aspen was completed in May 2016. The Little Nell will follow suit in April 2017, updating the 52 guest rooms, 26 premium guest rooms and 8 suites by just-named firm Champalimaud Design.
