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TAKE A SKI TRIP BACK IN TIME WITH NEW FINE ART PHOTOGRAPHY SERIES *GRAY MALIN IN ASPEN*

Aspen, Colorado (January 28, 2020) – In celebration of our 30th anniversary this ski season, <u>The Little Nell</u> teamed up with fine art photographer <u>Gray Malin</u> to debut his latest fine art series - Gray Malin in Aspen - highlighting the iconic glamour of Aspen ski culture with a vintage twist. Since its opening in 1989, The Little Nell has embodied the quintessential Aspen experience that is cosmopolitan yet intimate, modern yet timeless. In true Gray Malin fashion, the series that was just released online today pays homage to the beloved ski town and its first and only five-star, five-diamond property, to recreate a vintage wonderland.

Over the course of a week-long shoot in the height of a Colorado winter, Gray crafted scenes from his interpretation of Alpine society and moments that make Aspen Snowmass much more than just a place on a map. Featuring playfully positioned models in classic ski wardrobes and props including vintage Goyard and Louis Vuitton trunks, a 1950s Porsche, a loveable Bernese Mountain dog and more, he invokes and reimagines memories of the ski culture of yesteryear.

Though known for his remarkable aerial shots, this series is his first ski-specific retro collection that includes on-the-ground images for an immersive experience meant to transport viewers directly into a world of ski lifts, slopes and adventures. Other prominent Aspen locations in this series include Buckhorn Cabin on Aspen Mountain, Cloud Nine Alpine Bistro on Aspen Highlands, legendary for channeling authentic European Alpine culture in a warm, welcoming environment, and Lift 1A, which once was renowned as the longest ski lift in the world when it opened in 1947 as Lift 1.

"I am so thrilled to have been able to work with The Little Nell on this special photo series. My goal was to capture a vintage perspective on the undeniable glamour of this iconic location while conveying the sense of inclusiveness that is synonymous with Aspen's ski community," says Gray

Malin. "Styling vintage props and clothing from the 1950s-1980s against the stunning winter backdrops of Aspen was something out of a dream - I could feel the nostalgia in each photograph."

Special thanks to Vintage Ski World in Carbondale, Colo., for providing the many skis, props, sweaters, scarves, mittens, hats, snow boots and more that were used to revive the bygone ski era.
