The day includes an average number of 10 completely untracked powder runs on the backside of Aspen Mountain, followed by an intimate late-lunch at the Powder Tours cabin. The gourmet lunch will be perfectly paired with wines from around the world, specifically bottled for element 47.

The Little Nell Powder Tours experience is \$465 per person and if a group wants to buy out the cat (10 seats), the pricing will be \$400 per person. This snow cat offer is available to guests of The Little Nell, the Residences at The Little Nell and The Limelight Hotel. The Powder Tours terrain is blue and guests should be strong intermediate to advanced skiers/snowboarders in order to tackle and enjoy the terrain.

Groom Little Nell via Snowcat – Find out how the slopes of Aspen Mountain are perfected each evening by riding shotgun in one of our snowcat machines on select nights this upcoming 2014-2015 ski season. One of our grooming pros/snow cat operators will take just two guests at a time on an intimate behind-the-scenes ride in the "Bison 350" model of a top-of-the-line Prinoth snowcat. Guests will ride in style next to the driver as they learn how grooming the slopes work, get a glimpse into the daily operation of running at ski resort – all while enjoy the sunset and overlooking downtown of Aspen. The cost is \$100 for two people. Little Nell snowcat tours will leave at 5 p.m. Monday, Wednesday and Friday during the

ski season operating dates November 27, 2014 – April 19, 2015. This experience is open to guests of The Little Nell, Residences of The Little Nell and The Limelight Hotel.
